SUMMARY OF OPINION

TIMBERWISE OY / SINGLE-STRIP PARQUETS

Timberwise parquets are high-quality floorings that are emission-free and also manufactured entirely without the use of formaldehyde-containing treatment agents. These parquets are made of oak, ash, larch and pine.

In terms of allergies, parquets have been studied especially with regarding to the emissions from finished products, that is, volatile organic odours and the colouring methods and adhesives used. The emission levels from Timberwise parquets meet and are below the specified Allergy Label criteria, and therefore they are also suitable for demanding flooring applications where temperature and humidity vary greatly.

Low-emission parquets increase the comfort of living and make it possible to move in quickly after a new floor is installed. All Timberwise parquets that have the Allergy Label have a sturdy, cross-glued three-layer structure with Finnish hardwood birch plywood panel as the middle layer instead of the generally used softwood plywood. All parquets are available with the locking tongue and groove system, which means that gluing down the boards to the floor is not required. This contributes to the comfort of living because no additional chemicals are required for installing the floor. The single-strip parquets by Timberwise do not contain substances or such chemical concentrations that can be generally considered as irritating or sensitising.
